Paint Out at St. Joseph's Abbey

We were blessed with great weather for the annual paint out Friday, April 6. The Artworks at the abbey welcomed us into their space. We enjoyed delicious coffee and muffins before Alan Flattmann, President opened the meeting by welcoming everyone and giving a brief history of the Degas Pastel Society. Degas has grown from a small local group of pastellists into a group with international membership promoting the use of soft pastels. Glinda Schafer, a charter member, gave a delightful demonstration on the Abbey grounds. Following her demonstration, a buffet luncheon was served. Artists were then invited on a special tour of the Abbey's artwork or to paint on the grounds.

Glinda Schafer's Demonstration

After the opening at the Artworks, we moved to a nearby location where *Glinda Schafer* began her demonstration. She works wearing rubber gloves and uses a microfiber cloth to wipe her hands and clean pastels as needed. The painting surface is mounted on a dark board to avoid glare.



Demonstration in the Beginning

Using a variety of pastel brands, light and dark values were established to capture the light patterns of the scene. Shadows on the building were laid down with a soft brown followed by ground shadows. She used strokes in the direction of grass, leaves, etc. Makeup sponges were used to help blend the pastels and avoid "holidays", the light gaps in the pastel colors. A rolling motion with the pastel helped create a natural look for limbs and twigs and avoids having them look stiff. As she continued to work on the painting, she reminded us that we should always back up and look at the work in progress. Thank you Glinda for a beautiful and informative demonstration.

Honorable Mention in the "Landscape and Interiors" category were awarded to *Marcia Holmes* for "Fig Leaves Fall in Tuscany", *Bethany Fields* for "Glade at the Edge" and *Ray Hassard* for "In the Abandoned Silk Mill."

Mike Beeman received an honorable mention in the "Portrait and Figure" category for "Motion in Red."

In the "Still Life and Floral" category *Theresa Emmett Allison* was awarded 1st Place for "Once Upon a Time". Honorable Mentions went to *Jeri Greenberg* for "Berries in Glass" and *Theresa Emmett Allison* for "Head Over Heels".

The "Abstract and Non-Objective" category saw *Marcia Holmes* in 2nd Place with "Sunny Side Rose", *Betty Efferson* in 3rd Place with "Up and Away" and *Elaine Augustine* with an Honorable Mention for "Color Frenzy No.1".
