## Annual Degas Pastel Paint Out

Our paint out this year is scheduled for Wednesday, April 1 at Longue Vue House and Gardens, 7 Bamboo Road, New Orleans, LA 70124. We are excited to have as our demo artist this year **Carol Peebles**. She will do a demonstration of a figure in the gardens. The event will begin with a meet and greet from 9 to 10 a.m. It will be free of charge and artists can paint on the grounds in the afternoon after the demo.

Longue Vue House and Gardens, also known as Longue Vue, is a historic house museum and associated gardens. It is the former home of Edgar Stern and Edith Rosenwald Stern who owned Sears.

The current house is the second house built on the property. The original house and gardens began in 1924. In 1934, landscape architect Ellen Biddle Shipman began to work with the Sterns on the designs of their gardens. Through the re-working of the gardens the Sterns decided that their house did not allow them to fully enjoy their new grounds, and the original house was subsequently moved and a new one erected in its place starting in 1939.

The new house was designed by architects William and Geoffrey Platt whose father, Charles A. Platt, was Shipman's mentor. The four facades of the house have four different appearances each with a different garden. You will have a difficult time selecting the garden where you would like to paint.

# Introducing Our Juror/Judge for 2020

*Lyn Asselta* has been involved in fine art and fine craft for the past 25 years. Her extensive backgrounds has included elementary school art teacher, draftsman, calligrapher, workshop instructor, and creator of award-winning fine-art gourd vessels.

At one point, she opened an old box of Grumbacher pastels and never looked back. Pastel, as a medium, seems to be a perfect metaphor for her relationship to landscapes... vibrant, expressive, exuberant and tactile; pastel allows Lyn to hold a piece of color in her hand and to capture the essence of the wild, untouched beauty she finds in the world.

Lyn is a Signature Member of the Pastel Society of America (PSA), an International Association of Pastel Societies (IAPS) Eminent Pastelist, a member of the Salmagundi Club, the Eastern League of Professional Artists and American Women Artists. She is the founder of the First Coast Pastel Society (FL) and is a Member of Excellence of the Southeastern Pastel Society. Her award winning paintings have appeared in shows and exhibitions throughout the United States, and in invitational exhibitions in France and China. In 2009, Lyn had the honor of being an Artist in Residence for the National Park Service at Acadia National Park in Maine. Her work was featured in the February 2016 issue of Pastel Journal magazine and her painting "Blue Morning, Crescent Beach" appeared on its cover. She has also been featured in Pratique des Arts magazine and Plein Air magazine. In 2018, Lyn published her first book, Seeing the Landscape, a collection of her paintings and prose. Lyn travels extensively to teach both studio and plein air pastel landscape workshops.

Now living in a small town in midcoast Maine after 35 years in Florida, Lyn is inspired daily by new landscapes and changes of season. Her work is represented by Cutter & Cutter Fine Art, St. Augustine and Ponte Vedra, FL, and by Gleason Fine Art Gallery in Boothbay Harbor, Maine.

So, if you are interested in 7 days of plein air painting in a beautiful historical setting, enjoying delicious cuisine, wines and the camaraderie of fellow artists, then come join us for an engaging and memorable trip to Venice.
