Plein Air Painting & Sketching in ANDALUCIA, SPAIN October 1-11, 2021, Are you tired of being cooped up with the lockdown and eager to travel again? I have a great workshop trip you might want to consider to Andalucía, a beautiful region of southern Spain. The cost of the trip is a real bargain for a European destination and you can receive a \$200 discount if you sign up by April 1st. A \$500 deposit is required to reserve a space. I'm optimistic the trip will go, but if it has to be cancelled because of Covid travel restrictions, you will receive a full refund.

I first went to Andalucía 10 years ago with a workshop group and everyone had a wonderful time. We will be staying at Hotel Restaurant Bandolero, a small charming hotel and restaurant in the village of Juzcar in the mountainous Serrania de Ronda. Our hosts are the hotel owners, David Nuyen, originally from New York and Chef Ivan Sastre Pascual, from central Spain. All meals are

prepared by Chef Ivan who trained in both pastry and savory cuisine at the Cordon Bleu in London.

Our group will sketch and paint everyday in Juzcar and nearby villages and towns. We will also make one long day trip to the old town center of Seville. Non-artists are welcome to come along on all excursions to explore and enjoy the area.

The cost of the workshop and tour is \$2400 per person based on double occupancy. The fee for non-artists is \$2200. Add \$400 for single occupancy. Cost includes: hotel accommodations with private room and bath for 10 days, tuition for workshop, shuttle from and to airport in Malaga, transportation to painting locations, all breakfasts, dinners and most lunches.
