We are sad to report the passing of Marjorie Johnson on August 20, 2021. Marjorie was a founding member and president of the Degas Pastel Society from 1995 to 1998. She was also a two-term president of the New Orleans Art Association. Marjorie won many awards for her portraits and still life paintings in juried exhibitions. Marjorie was born in Washington, North Carolina in 1925, but moved to New Orleans in 1952 and always considered New Orleans her home. She will be greatly missed by all who knew her.




