Shoshanna Ahart. For the second year in a row, I have collaborated with the German publishing house, Spurbuchverlag to create a spectacular Art Calendar. The calendar features 12 different images of my pastel paintings, including works from my Gruenau series, and is a vertical format measuring 12" x 8.5". The painting used for the calendar cover, Enchanted Meadow, features Gruenau Castle's inner courtyard. The days of the week and months of the year are in both German and English. A collection of select pieces is now showing at Frameworks Gallery, 516 Moore Street, Suite 102, Baton Rouge, LA. "Monet's Garden" won the Sponsor Award at the Arts Council of Pointe Coupee 12th Treasures of Pointe Coupee Exhibit. Added bonus - the piece also sold and is being enjoyed in its new home. The exhibit recently took place over two weekends in June. "Jack" was recently juried into the River Road National Juried Exhibition which will take place August 3 - Sept 29, 2022 at the Louisiana State Archives Gallery, 3851 Essen Lane, Baton Rouge, LA. Reception: Sept 15th from 5 - 7 p.m. Open to the public Mon - Fri, 8 am - 4:30 pm, gallery admission is free. Betty was also privileged to be commissioned by the West Jefferson Medical Center for a series of 15 paintings. It brings me joy knowing my paintings were selected to help soften the spaces and contribute to healing while creating a positive environment for workers and caregivers.

William A. Schneider's pastel painting, "Matiana" won the Award of Excellence (PPSCC Award) in the Shades of Pastel

2022 National Juried Exhibition. The Juror of Awards was Master Pastelist, Nancie King Mertz. The exhibition was held at the renowned Mansion at Strathmore in North Bethesda, MD. His painting "Rhapsody in Blue" received the "Great American Award" (4th Place) in the 36th Annual International Open Exhibition sponsored by the Northwest Pastel Society. The show was exhibited at The American Art Company Gallery in Tacoma, WA. (the oldest fine art gallery in the Northwest - established in 1889!) The Juror of Awards was Master Pastelist, Albert Handell. This painting had previously won "Best Pastel" in the Plein Air Salon competition in January of this year. "Myrrh Sea" received the Central Massachusetts Pastel Society Award in the 29th Annual National Juried Exhibition, Renaissance in Pastel sponsored by the Connecticut Pastel Society. This year's exhibition was held at the Lyme Art Association Gallery in Old Lyme, CT. The Juror of Awards was noted pastelist, Eileen Casey.

Rebecca Yates Shorb received an honorable mention at the Spring Members Show at the Hanover Arts Guild in Pennsylvania. She also presented a demonstration for the Art Alliance of Franklin County titled "On the Surface". In May and June she will be showing at the Damariscotta Grill in Maine.
