DPS Workshop The Intentional Landscape With Lyn Asselta, IAPS-EP, PSA-MP November 15-17, 2024

Degas Pastel's next workshop will be at the Gulfport Arts Center, Gulfport, MS. Lyn Asselta will be the instructor. Her work has been featured in several books on the pastel medium, as well as in the Pastel Journal, Pratique de Arts and Plein Air magazines.

For a landscape painting to have a voice, the artist must know the story they wish to tell. Rather than being a collection of objects, the painting must convey more complex ideas like emotion, distance, and atmosphere. The artist needs to know clearly "why" they want to create a painting before the technical choices of the process come into focus and work to tell the painting's story. This workshop will focus on narrowing down your intent for a painting, then allowing that intent to help you choose everything from your composition to your color palette.

Only 14 participants will be accepted. DPS Member Cost is \$450 and Non-Members \$480. A deposit of \$250 made payable to Degas Pastel Society must be sent with a registration form.
